

In the school year 2021/2022, the teaching process at UWC Mostar takes place in accordance with instructions from the Ministry of Education, Science, Culture and Sports of the Herzegovina-Neretva Canton, dated 03/9/2021 and the opinion of the Ministry of Health, Labor and Social Welfare of the Herzegovina-Neretva Canton.

In order to prevent the spread of COVID 19 in the school year 2021/2022, the teaching model process contains 4 levels that will be applied depending on the percentage of infected teachers / students:

1. The green level means that all students attend classes for the full duration of the class, in accordance with the standards, respecting the epidemiological measures and recommendations that are in force when the number of infected teachers / students is up to 10%.
2. The yellow level is applied in a situation when the number of infected teachers / students is 11% -20% and implies that students attend classes for 30 minutes. Secondary school students attend classes according to the 18+ or 7 + 7 model for 30 minutes, without restrictions on their stay in school, in compliance with epidemiological measures and recommendations that are in force.
3. The orange level is applied in a situation when the number of infected teachers / students is 21% -30% and implies that high school students attend classes according to the model 15+ or 7 + 7 for 30 minutes, with a maximum limit of school stay for 3 hours in compliance with the epidemiological measures and recommendations in force.
4. The red level is applied in a situation when the number of infected teachers / students is higher than 31% and implies that high school students attend classes online

Fortunately, at UWC Mostar from the beginning of the school year until today, the teaching process takes place in the green level in compliance with epidemiological measures and recommendations in force (maintaining social distance, washing and disinfecting hands, wearing a mask indoors).

Orders of the Crisis Headquarters of the Federal Ministry of Health, dated 4/11/2021

I. GENERAL ORDERS

1. The cantonal governments, ie the crisis headquarters of the cantonal ministries of health, are ordered to adopt more restrictive measures in relation to the measures from this order, in accordance with the risk assessment of events that may worsen the epidemiological situation, as well as the current epidemiological situation, the number of hospitalized patients, the number of patients using respiratory support and the availability of all resources in health care (technical, human, etc.).

2. It is ordered to wear protective masks over the mouth and nose to protect the respiratory system indoors and with a distance of at least 2 meters. It is mandatory to wear a mask in the open if a distance of 2 meters cannot be achieved. It is mandatory to wear masks at bus, tram, trolleybus, minibus stops, platforms and markets / open markets and other places where there is a greater fluctuation of population. Exceptionally, protective masks are not required:

- children under the age of six, people who have breathing problems due to chronic diseases or who cannot remove the mask without the help of another person, e.g. people with intellectual disabilities or hearing impairments, people with hearing impairments
- primary school students from 1st to 5th grade during classes in classrooms
- athletes at matches, trainings and sports activities, riders on bicycles, electric scooters and motorcycles
- members of the same family who cannot achieve a distance of 2 meters in the open.

3. It is allowed to gather people in a certain area under the following conditions:

- no more than 50 people indoors
- no more than 100 people in the open space

All gatherings within the stated limits must take place in a space that allows a mandatory physical distance of at least 2 meters between persons (except members of the same household).

In order to reduce the risk of COVID-19, as well as the protection of personal health, during the gathering it is necessary to adhere to the recommendations issued by the institutes of public health in the Federation of BiH (hygienic and epidemiological measures). The organizers of the gathering are responsible for implementing the measures. The organizer is obliged to act in accordance with the regulations on public gatherings.

4. The crisis headquarters of the cantonal ministries of health are ordered to reduce the number of persons, from the maximum number of persons in open and closed areas in accordance with item 3 of this order, at rallies, such as: political gatherings, weddings, funerals, and other family gatherings and similar events, in order to prevent the spread of COVID-19 infection among the population, as well as to protect the personal health and public health of the population.

5. Notwithstanding item 3 of this order, it is allowed to organize larger gatherings, up to a maximum of 150 people indoors and 300 people outdoors, provided that the size of the space allows the implementation of hygienic and epidemiological measures.

The condition is that all participants have:

- negative antigen or PCR test, not older than 48 hours, or
- COVID-19 certificate, not older than 6 months
- or a certificate of completed vaccination

The organizer of the conference is responsible for the implementation of epidemiological measures and the organization of the meeting.

The organizer of the meeting from this point is obliged to obtain prior consent from the competent crisis headquarters of the cantonal Ministry of Health, which is issued based on the opinion of the competent public health institute of the canton, which contains a risk assessment.

6. In the conditions of COVID-19 epidemiological situation in the Federation of BiH, it is ordered to strictly follow the recommendations of the Institute of Public Health of the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina, for all those to whom the recommendations apply, which are available at www.zzjzfbih.ba, as follows:

- recommendations for BiH citizens and foreign citizens entering BiH;
- recommendations - public transport;
- recommendations for museums, galleries, cinemas, etc .;
- recommendations for catering facilities;
- recommendations for schools in the context of COVID-19 for the school year 2021/2022. year;
- recommendations - kindergartens;
- recommendations for dental practices;
- recommendations - permanent accommodation and care;
- recommendations for sports and recreational activities - supplement;
- recommendations for the operation of the hotel;
- recommendations for shops, services, shopping malls;
- recommendations - celebrations;
- recommendations for the work of student dormitories in the context of COVID-19.

7. The Federal Administration for Inspection Affairs and cantonal administrations for inspection affairs, as well as inspections organized at the competent ministries in the canton, ie the competent municipal and city inspectors, are ordered to continuously monitor the implementation of the Order under item. 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 of this Chapter and in accordance with their powers take measures within their competence, which includes the initiation of criminal charges against perpetrators who are suspected of failing to carry out orders in a COVID pandemic -19 for criminal offences punishable under the Criminal Code of the Federation of BiH.

8. The competent police administrations and the competent prosecutor's offices are required to act urgently on the submitted criminal charges from item 7 of this order, in accordance with their powers.
