- Readiness and qualifications to teach ToK in addition to the subject advertised.
- Willingness to assume pastoral care duties as house parent or residential mentor.
- International mindedness and ability to work well in a multicultural environment.

- Commitment to UWC mission and values.
- Willingness to engage students beyond regular classroom hours.
- Ability and willingness to actively participate in the school's Co-curricular program.
