

Call for Alumni Board Members UWC Mostar

UWC Mostar's Alumni Board is a volunteer alumni-led group that assists the college with alumni related tasks and engagement. Our main focus is to build a stronger connection between the school and alumni, strengthen intra-alumni relations and provide space for alumni to stay connected with each other and UWCiM. The board is organized in three internal committees - PR, Fundraising and Alumni Relations, to help us better act on our priorities.

Since 2018, we have focused on (i) helping the school develop an alumni database and make sure they can reach as many of us as possible, (ii) growing our alumni fundraising records with the EUR1 Campaign, thanks to which we have fundraised for the first alumni-funded scholarship, and (iii) creating spaces for alumni to get together with social events and alumni talks at the school.

We are looking for 2 new members who are interested in supporting UWC Mostar and its alumni community. Time commitment: **1-3 hours per month**. Sample responsibilities outlined below.

Sample Responsibilities of the Alumni Board

- ❖ Improve communication between alumni and college:
 - Assist the school in setting up its alumni communication plan (incl. social media) and help gather and action alumni feedback
- ❖ Develop and strengthen intra-alumni relations
 - Organize networking events and alumni gatherings
 - Seek and action new activities based on alumni feedback
- ❖ Develop a space for alumni to share professional experiences and insights with current students and each other
 - Organize spaces for alumni to share professional insights/advice and establish a mentorship program
 - Create a way for alumni help current students' in their university search process
- ❖ Support the college's fundraising efforts
 - Encourage fellow alumni to support school-led fundraising campaigns
 - Identify fundraising focus areas based on alumni feedback
