In his successesful career he has played with major orchestras around the world, including the London Philharmonia, Budapest Festival, Hungarian National Philharmonic English Chamber, Berlin Radio, Istanbul Chamber, Venezuela Simon Bolivar, New Zealand, Montreal and Isreal Symphony Orchestras.

He has worked with a number of musicians, among them Yuri Bashmet, Sir Andrew Davis, Zoltán Kocsis, Miklós Perényi, Mstislav Rostropovitch, Barbara Hendricks, Sergei Nakariakov, Vladimir Spivakov, Tamás Vásáry, the Keller, Takács, and Tokyo String Quartets.
