



With much sadness, we say farewell to our great friend and esteemed colleague and trustee of the UWC Mostar Endowment 'Bridge to the Future', Sir Mike Jackson.

General Sir Mike Jackson GCB CBE DSO DL was Chief of the General Staff of the British Army from 2003 to 2006. The

Times has described him as "the highest-profile CGS since Montgomery, and one of the last big beasts". He held

various significant roles during the war in former Yugoslavia, as commander of the United Nations Protection

Force (UNPROFOR) from 1995 and Commander of NATO's Allied Rapid Reaction Corps (ARRC) in 1997. In June

1999, the US Supreme Commander of Nato ordered Sir Mike Jackson to block the runway in Pristina, worried that the

Russians may fly in reinforcements. Sir Mike's response was 'I am not going to start World War III for you'. In the end,

the situation was defused — helped by a hip flask of whisky that Jackson shared with his Russian counterpart.

Through these experiences in the former Yugoslavia he developed a soft spot for that region. He was delighted to become a trustee of the UWC Mostar endowment 'Bridge to the Future' which seeks to ensure scholarships for young and bright students from the Western Balkan region and elsewhere to attend the United World Colleges in Mostar. The mission of UWCs is to unite people through education for a peaceful and sustainable future.

We will miss his wisdom, his wit and his direct style in communicating. Whether in person, or on zoom, "General Mike" was a strong and charismatic presence.

We send our deepest condolences to his wife Sarah, who is also a friend of the UWC Mostar Endowment, and to his children, Amanda, Mark and Tom.

Thank you General Mike, we will miss you.
